

### 1. What do you need to do

- Create and share one creative post (any ONE of the following)
- 1. A short video (reel/tiktok-style/max 1-2 minutes)
- 2. A photo with a strong caption

- A message of inspiration
- A designed Scene: Be creative in setting your scene using TVET-related tools or environments. For example, you may film in a workshop or training area, or use tools related to your trade. These are only examples, feel free to design your own innovative setting.
